

Dr. Craig Orgeron called the meeting to order.

Ms. Dana Wilson presented a request from the Mississippi Department of Revenue for approval of an alternative model for calculation of transaction and Electronic Government Fees associated with credit card payments for the Department's Quick Pay and TAP applications. DOR would like to standardize on a flat fee of 2.5% of the total purchase amount for credit card payments across all applications to keep the charges consistent to the end users. The current fee for the DOR TAP Application is 2.2% of the total purchase amount + \$1.00.

Dr. Orgeron asked for a motion to approve the proposed funding model. Ms. Samantha Atkinson moved approval. The motion was seconded by Mr. Jim Hurst and the motion carried with none opposed.
