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Dr. Craig Orgeron called the meeting to order.

Dr. Craig Orgeron called for a motion to approve the minutes of the February 19, 2019 meeting if no changes were needed. Mr. Jesse Graham made the motion to accept the minutes, it was seconded by Mr. Jim Hurst. The motion passed with none opposed.

Ms. Dana Wilson presented the Portal Highlights and Current Projects portion of the EOC reports. She featured the new website developed for the Board of Nursing. She also featured the addition of Auto-Renewal of Hunting and Fishing Licenses for the Mississippi Department of Wildlife Fisheries and Parks noting that Mississippi is one of the first states to offer this feature. The application will be featured by StateScoop magazine. 72% of customers renewing their licenses online elected to opt-in for auto renewal.

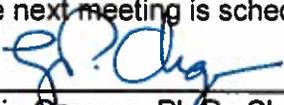

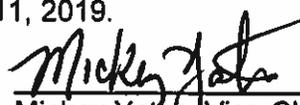

Mr. Jesse Graham moved that MSI send a reminder notice to all agencies asking that they complete the PCI survey or update previously reported information as applicable. This will be followed by a letter from DFA and ITS explaining the importance of demonstrating PCI Compliance and the consequences of failure to comply. Dr. Orgeron will work with MSI and the agencies making minor changes to the communications to keep the process moving and report back to the Committee if any issues arise. The motion was seconded by Mr. Mickey Yates and carried with none opposed.

Mr. Clay Johnston moved to retain Craig Orgeron as Committee Chairman and Mickey Yates as Committee Vice-Chairman. Ms. Samantha Atkinson seconded. The motion carried with none opposed.
