Ms. Tina Wells presented the Portal Highlights and Current Projects portion of the EOC reports:








- **Mississippi State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering**
  - In response to the merger of the Board of Cosmetology and Board of Barber Examiners, our team launched updates to the online exam registration, allowing barbering students to register for licensing exams. This resulted in a 20% increase in scheduled exams in February. These updates were made at no additional cost as part of our self-funded model. Additionally, we met with the newly formed board to discuss their goals and plan to demo mobile inspection platforms to modernize their statewide inspection processes.
- **MEMA Website**
  - Redesigned with improved functionality tailored to serve Mississippians and visitors better.
  - A cleaner navigation with a simplified UI. Fully responsive—looks great on any screen size. Built with accessibility tools & multilingual support in mind.
- **Tyler launched two websites:**

- **Department of Banking and Consumer Finance**
  - Tyler MS has continued to work alongside the Department of Banking and Consumer Finance to enhance the semi-annual bank assessment process. The second FY25 assessment saw improved adoption and 42% growth in funds collected over the initial assessment.
- **Mississippi Department of Employment Security**
  - Governor's Job Fair Employer Registration Refresh
    - We're developing a new system that will make managing job fair events, registrations, and payments more efficient, with an easy-to-use interface and streamlined workflows.
  - A Smarter, Simpler Website
    - We're redesigning the site to make it easier for employers and job seekers to find opportunities and resources. A new AI-powered,

multilingual chatbot will boost accessibility, reduce support calls, and free up staff to focus on what matters most.
